The Book of James Chapter 1 verse 1.

"James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes scattered among the nations: Greetings."

1. The Book of Ecclesiasticus Chapter 23 verse 19: "Such a man only feareth the eyes of men, and knoweth not that the eyes of the Lord are ten thousand times brighter than the sun, beholding all the ways of men, and considering the most secret parts."

2. The Book of Exodus Chapter 33 verse 10 - 23:

"And all the people saw the cloudy pillar stand *at* the tabernacle door: and all the people rose up and worshipped, every man *in* his tent door.

And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

And Moses said unto the LORD, See, thou sayest unto me, Bring up this people: and thou hast not let me know whom thou wilt send with me. Yet thou hast said, I know thee by name, and thou hast also found grace in my sight.

Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found grace in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find grace in thy sight: and consider that this nation *is* thy people.

And he said, My presence shall go *with* thee, and I will give thee rest.

And he said unto him, If thy presence go not *with* me, carry us not up hence.

For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? *is it not in that thou goest with us?* so shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that *are* upon the face of the earth.

And the LORD said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that thou hast spoken: for thou hast found grace in my sight, and I know thee by name.

And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory.

And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.

And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.

And the LORD said, Behold, *there is* a place by me, and thou shalt stand upon a rock: And it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by: And I will take away mine hand, and thou shalt see my back parts: but my face shall not be seen."

3. **The Book of 2nd Esdras** Chapter 13 verse 29 - 31: "Behold, the days come, when the most High will begin to deliver them that are upon the earth.
And he shall come to the astonishment of them that dwell on the earth. And one shall undertake to fight against another, one city against another, one place against another, one people against another, and one realm against another."
4. **The Book of Isaiah** Chapter 6 verse 1: "In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple."
5. **The Book of Numbers** Chapter 33 verse 50 - 56: "And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho, saying,
Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan;
Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their pictures, and destroy all their molten images, and quite pluck down all their high places:
And ye shall dispossess *the inhabitants* of the land, and dwell therein: for I have given you the land to possess it.
And ye shall divide the land by lot for an inheritance among your families: *and* to the more ye shall give the more inheritance, and to the fewer ye shall give the less inheritance:
every man's *inheritance* shall be in the place where his lot falleth; according to the tribes of your fathers ye shall inherit.
But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them *shall be* pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell.
Moreover it shall come to pass, *that* I shall do unto you, as I thought to do unto them."
6. **The Book of Numbers** Chapter 15 verse 38: "Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue:"

7. **The Book of John** Chapter 1 verse 18: "No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*."
8. **The Book of Jeremiah** Chapter 4 verse 22: "For my people *is* foolish, they have not known me; they *are* sottish children, and they have none understanding; they *are* wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge."



Incorruptible Crowns

The Book of Revelations Chapter 3 verse 11: "Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown."



The Book of 1st Corinthians Chapter 9 verse 25: "And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an Incorruptible."

Salvation

The Book of Jeremiah Chapter 30 verse 11: "For I am with thee, saith the LORD, to save thee: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered thee, yet will I not make a full end of thee: but I will correct thee in measure, and will not leave thee altogether unpunished."



The Book of Isaiah Chapter 49 verse 6: "And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth."



Exit Stage Left

1. **The Book of 1st Kings** Chapter 7 verse 21: “And he set up the pillars in the porch of the temple: and he set up the right pillar, and called the name thereof Jachin: and he set up the left pillar, and called the name thereof Boaz.”
2. **The Book of Ecclesiastes** Chapter 10 verse 2: “A wise man's heart *is* at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left.”
3. **The Book of Matthew** Chapter 7 verse 15: “Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.”
4. **The Book of Nehemiah** Chapter 8 verse 4: “And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, and Meshullam.”
5. **The Book of Psalms** Chapter 58 verse 3: “The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies.”
6. **The Book of Jeremiah** Chapter 1 verse 5: “Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, *and* I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.”



APOCRYPHA

The Book of Sirach also known as **the book of Ecclesiasticus Chapter 44 verse 17:** (Meaning Church Book): “Noah was found perfect and righteous; in the time of wrath he was taken in exchange for the world; therefore was he left as a remnant unto the earth, when the flood came.”

The Book of the Wisdom of Solomon Chapter 5 verse 18: "He shall put on righteousness as a breastplate, and true judgment instead of an helmet."


The Book of Ephesians Chapter 6 verse 14: "Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness."




































