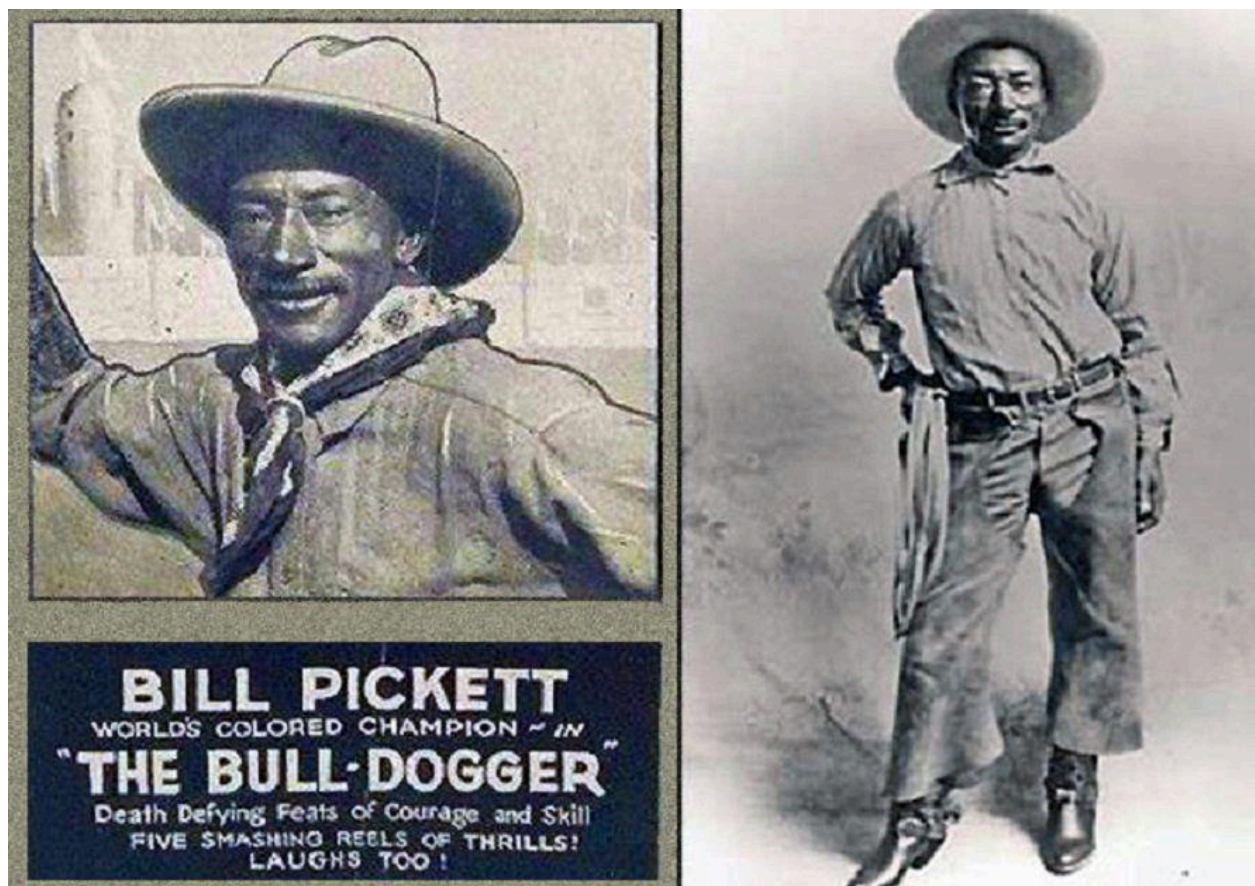
The Book of Genesis Chapter 13 verse 7 {English Standard Version}

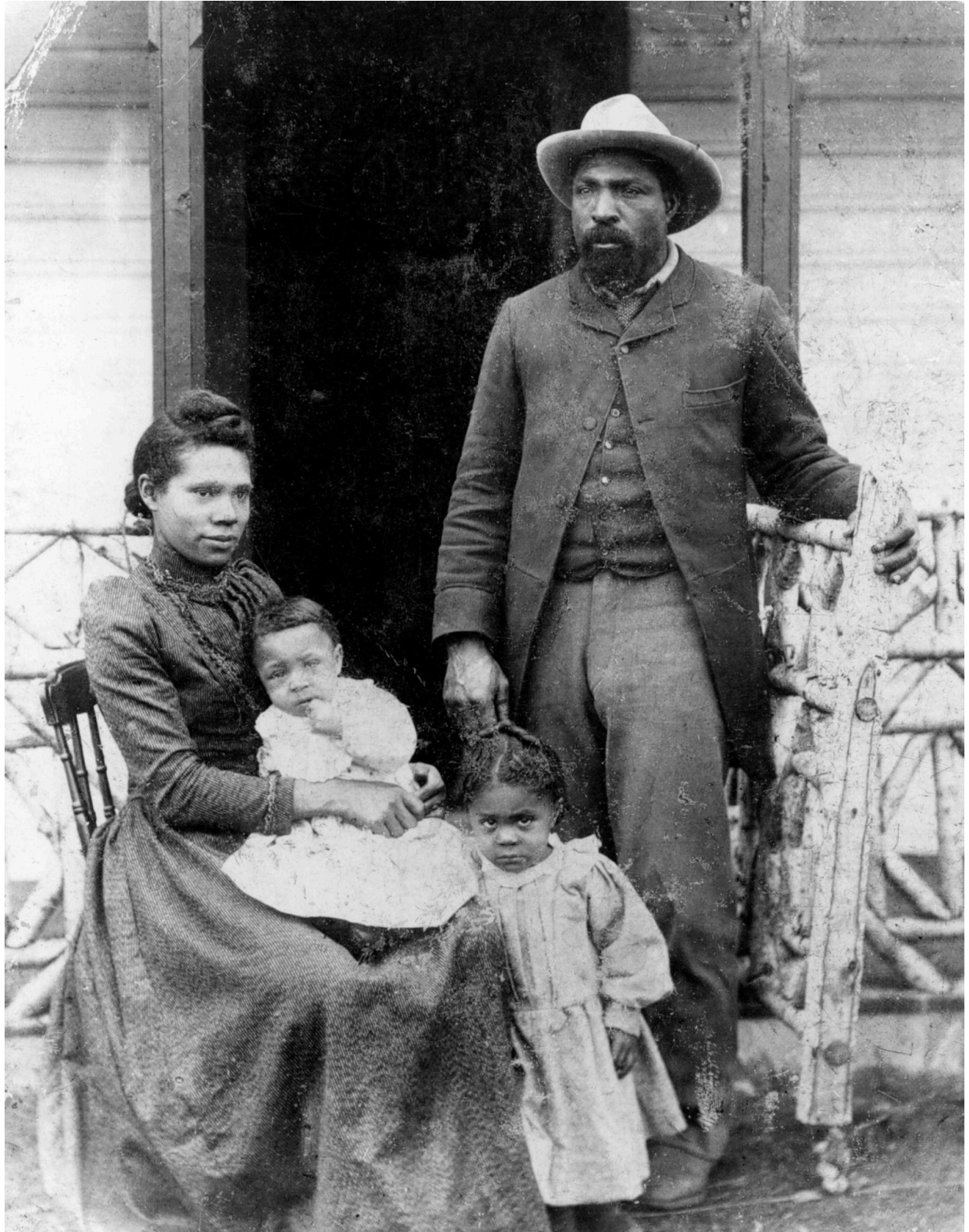
